



Admission exam 2022-2023 in Endodontology

Components of the test:

1- Written exam:

- Covers a broad spectrum of areas related to pulp and periapical diseases; diagnosis, and treatment planning, endodontic instruments and materials; instrumentation and obturation techniques.
- Test format include MCQ and case study; written skills will be assessed.
- Time allowed is 60 minutes.

2- Practical exam:

- Access opening, Instrumentation and obturation of a root canal
- The practical exam will take place in the Micro Endodontics lab on natural extracted teeth.
- Instruments and materials: applicants should get their own endodontic instruments and material needed for complete root canal treatment. In addition to three freshly extracted teeth (1 molar, 1 premolar, and 1 central or lateral incisor).
- Infection control measures is applied in the lab (lab coat/scrub, mask, gloves, face shield).
- Time allowed is 90 minutes.
